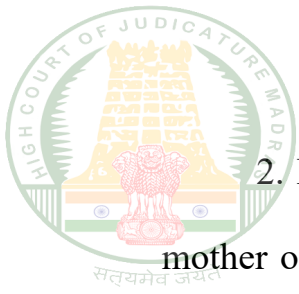

ORDER

The present writ petition is filed praying for a writ of Mandamus directing respondents 1 and 2 to deposit the Insurance policy amount payable under the SBI Life Insurance policy No.3N315963106 and also direct the 3rd respondent to deposit all the dues payable to the legal heirs of late Mohamed Rasheel S/o shahul Hameed to the credit of this writ petition and further direct the 3rd Respondent to furnish all details to the petitioners to workout their remedies.



2. Learned counsel for petitioners would submit that 1st petitioner is the mother of petitioners 2 and 3. 1st petitioner lost her husband in an accident in the year 2025. It is submitted that 1st petitioner's husband was employed with the 3rd respondent and that there are certain dues which the petitioner's deceased husband is entitled to. In view of differences between 1st petitioner and respondents 4 and 5 (parents of deceased), to ensure the interest of 1st petitioner's minor children are not affected, he would request that this Court may direct the concerned respondents to deposit the sum due to the deceased/ 1st petitioner's husband in his capacity as the employee with the Registrar General, Madras High Court in the form of Demand Draft and the Registrar General in turn may deposit the same in an interest bearing deposit till the disposal of this writ petition.

3. In that view of the matter, the 3rd respondent is directed to issue a demand draft in respect of the sums that are due to 1st petitioner's husband, in favour of Registrar General, Madras High Court, after issuance of calculation memo to the 1st petitioner as well as petitioners 4 and 5 within a period of two weeks from the date of uploading of web copy of the order without waiting for receipt of certified copy. The Registrar General, Madras High Court, in turn shall deposit the same in an interest bearing deposit till the disposal of this writ petition. To which, respondents 4 and 5 does not have any serious objection.



4. When this Court pointed out that this matter may be amicably resolved through mediation, learned counsel for 1st petitioner as well counsel for respondents 4 and 5 expressed their willingness to the above suggestion.

5. Learned counsel for respondents 4 and 5 would submit that the parents of the deceased employee/ respondents 4 & 5, are Senior Citizens and they are presently residing in Erode. He would further submit that they may have some difficulty in travelling from Erode to Chennai. On the other hand, learned counsel for petitioners would submit that 1st petitioner along with her children are presently residing in United Kingdom and are being represented by their power of Attorney, who would appear on behalf of the petitioners for mediation.

6. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for both sides, this matter is referred to the Tamil Nadu Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Madurai Bench, Madras High Court, for settlement on 29.06.2026.
