There is some difficulty expressed by all the parties and there has been some blame game, each one accusing the other. Even the Commissioner has expressed some difficulty in holding the cross-examination.

2. Without getting into the merit of the same, this Court suspends the cross-examination and orders continuation of cross-examination of P.W.1 through Virtual Court.

3. The matter is now posted before learned Additional Master III, which Court alone has the Virtual Court facilities.

4. Learned counsel for the plaintiff submitted that in between, the husband of P.W.1 had taken ill and was hospitalised.

5. Since there is a peril of best evidence being lost to the Court, learned Additional Master III is required to give top priority to this case. Further, cross-examination is required to be conducted on day today basis.

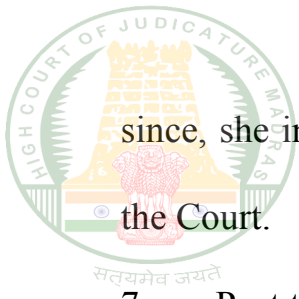
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6. Ms.L. Akshaya [Enrol.No.MS 4017/2019], Advocate Commissioner is
