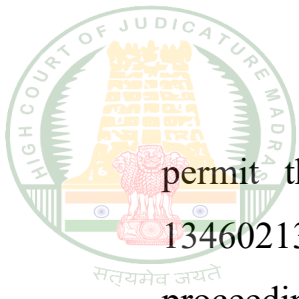

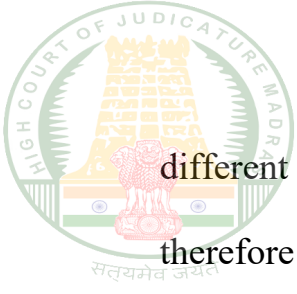

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the 1st respondent to permit the petitioner to operate the Savings Bank account bearing No. 1346021362 as sought vide representation dated 26/6/23 in light of the proceedings of the 3rd respondent dated 3/7/23 in Na.Ka. G.S. No. 267/ Che/ Va.Ka. 2023.

2. The case of the petitioner is that the petitioner is the hereditary Muthawalli of the Wakf and the Wakf is holding the savings bank account with the 1st respondent bank. While so, based on the objection made by the 4th respondent, the 1st respondent had frozen the wakf's bank account. Therefore, the petitioner has filed this Writ Petition seeking for the aforesaid relief.

3. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as the 1st respondent would submit that a



different person was appointed as Muthawalli in the place of the petitioner and therefore nothing survives for adjudication in this writ petition.

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4. In view of the submission made by the petitioner as well as the 1st respondent, this Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.
