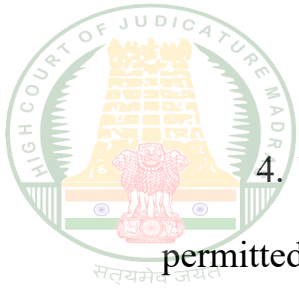
ORDER

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This Original Application has been filed to grant an Interim injunction against the Respondent restraining the Respondent from, in any manner, interfering with the Applicant's rights as a member of the Respondent except after hearing the Applicant and considering his submissions in a just and fair manner, pending disposal of the arbitration proceedings.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the applicant.

3. Considering the fact that the last of the Elections to the respondent had been held as early as in the year 2015 and that action initiated by the Registrar of Societies to initiate action against the office bearers so elected, apart from taking steps to take administration of the society under the Societies Registration Act, which had been enjoined to by this Court in C.S.No.339 of 2020 and also of the fact that the very same office bearers continued to be in office without conducting any election whatsoever as per the bye-laws and also being *prima facie* satisfied with the allegations raised by the applicant that unilateral decisions have been taken to remove members similarly placed to that of the applicant without giving any opportunity, much less even reasons, there shall be an order of injunction as prayed for.



4. Notice to the respondent returnable in four weeks. Private Notice is permitted through Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due.

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5. List the matter after four (4) weeks.
