It is seen from the notice papers that notice taken to first respondent has been returned with an endorsement “died” and the notice taken to the 3rd respondent has been returned with an endorsement “left”.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the 2nd respondent submitted that the respondents 2 and 3 are the L.Rs of the deceased first respondent.

3. The above statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and the 2nd respondent is recorded and the respondents 2 and 3 are recorded as L.Rs of the deceased first respondent.

4. Registry is directed to carryout necessary amendment.

5. Issue fresh notice to the 3rd respondent, returnable by 01.07.2026.

6. The learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to pay batta for taking notice to the correct address of the 3rd respondent on or before 17.06.2026, ***failing which, this civil miscellaneous petition shall stand dismissed automatically as against the 3rd respondent.***

7. If the counsel for the petitioner pays batta, within the stipulated time, the Registry is directed to send notice to the 3rd respondent, returnable by 01.07.2026.

8. List the matter on 01.07.2026.
