ORDER

The subject Writ Petition was dismissed for non-prosecution on 06.09.2024. The petitioner has filed Writ Miscellaneous Petition to restore the Writ Petition to the file of this Court for being decided on merits.

2. Mr.R.Bharanidharan, learned counsel for the first respondent submits that pursuant to the interim direction of this Court dated 23.09.2021, the petitioner was permitted to write the examination conducted for the post of Assistant Public Prosecutor Grade-II.

3. The learned Standing Counsel further submitted that the



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petitioner thereafter approached this Court by another Writ Petition,

pursuant to which she was also allowed to take part in the interview and

that the result of the petitioner was withheld on account of pendency of

the present Writ Petition.

4. The learned Standing Counsel further submitted that since the petitioner is challenging to the imposition of condition of having knowledge in Tamil, the issue becomes academic if the petitioner is not successful in the over all selection process i.e., by taking into consideration the marks secured by her in the written examination as well as in the oral interview.

5. The learned Standing Counsel further submitted that therefore, this Court may consider as to whether the petitioner is successful in the selection process or not to proceed further with the matter.

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6. Considering the above submission, this Court is of the view that the first respondent is to be directed to place before this Court the result of the petitioner in a sealed cover containing the marks secured by her in the written test as well as in the oral interview held for selecting the suitable candidates for the post of Assistant Public Prosecutor and also mentioning the cut-off mark in order to be selected for the above post.

7. Post the matter on 05.12.2025.

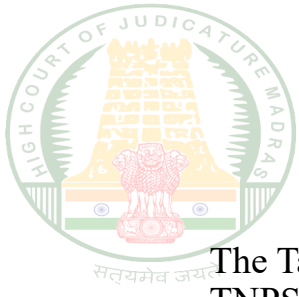
