It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had received order for export of Frozen Boneless Buffalo Meat. For the purpose of complying with the above export orders the petitioner after procuring buffalo meat from suppliers in Telengana had filed Shipping Bill No.3866244 dated 09.09.2024 at the port of Chennai. The above export was covered by Commercial Invoice, Packing List, E-way Bill, APEDA Certificate dated 22.09.2021 from Ministry of Commerce and Industry and a Health Certificate issued by a Veterinary Officer, Government of Telengana and also a Pre-Shipment Certificate No.HCM/TE03/2024-25/00376. However, the same was detained on the premise that the goods that are meant to be exported is Ox Meat and not Buffalo Meat and thus prohibited. It was submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the detention is illegal and without jurisdiction.

2. After submitting for a brief while the learned counsel for the petitioner would request that they may be granted liberty to file an application under Section 110A of the Act, to which the learned counsel for the respondent would submit that if



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any such application is made the same would be considered and orders would be passed in accordance with law.

3. In view there of the liberty is granted to the petitioner to file an application under Section 110A of the Act and the respondent is directed to pass orders within a period of 2 weeks from the date of receipt of application under Section 110A of the Act.

4. Registry is directed to tag this matter along with W.P.Nos.28951,28956, 32447, 32450, 32454, 32455, 34362 and 34893 of 2024.

5. Post the matter after 4 weeks.
