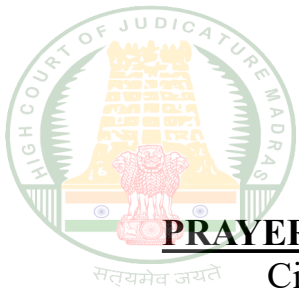

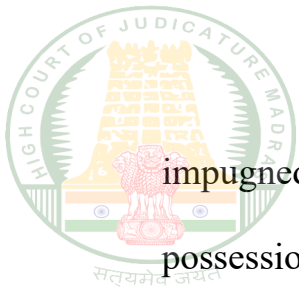

**ORDER**

Mr.M.Jayakumar, learned counsel for the petitioner represented and requested that he comes on change of vakalath only today and he is going to enter his appearance before the Registry in the above revision today by filing change of vakalat.

2. This matter has been posted for reporting compliance, subsequent to the specific direction issued in the revision on 24.11.2025. The respondents have taken up the matter before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and on 05.01.2026, the Hon'ble Supreme Court had dismissed the SLP. Therefore, the respondents have no other option, except to comply with the order of this Court. The respondent, admittedly, is not reporting compliance, today. Hence, a direction is issued to the learned Additional Sub Judge, Pondicherry to immediately issue a direction to the Court Bailiff to give effect to the order which was originally



impugned in the revision petition in E.P.No.181 of 1998 and hand over the possession of 'ABCD' portion marked in the Advocate Commissioner's Report by 23.01.2026. It is made clear that the Court Bailiff shall not take note of any obstruction of any third parties claiming any independent right or the judgment debtor, since the matter has attained the finality up to the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
