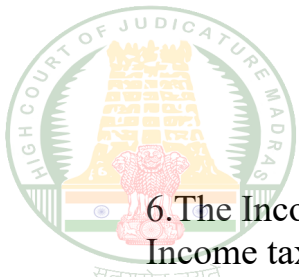

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the Respondent No.1 to 6 to take appropriate action against the 7th respondent for his illegal actions.

2. Mr.R.Sanjay, learned Central Government Standing Counsel takes notice on behalf of respondents 1 & 2. Mr.V.Umakanth, learned Government Advocate takes notice on behalf of the 2nd respondent. As no adverse order is being passed against the 7th respondent, notice to the 7th respondent is dispensed with.



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3. It is the case of the petitioner that the he is working as a driver-cum -office assistant in the 6th respondent co-operative society and that the 7th respondent, Jayasankar who is serving as a Secretary was involved in illegal activities including misappropriation of funds of the society during the course of his employment in respect of which, a criminal case has also been registered. In this regard, the petitioner submitted a representation 01.04.2025 to the 1st respondent seeking appropriate action against the 7th respondent. However, the said representation has not been considered till date. Hence, the present Writ Petition.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, it would suffice, if this Court issues a direction to the 1st respondent to dispose of the representation dated 23.09.2025 of the petitioner within the time that may be stipulated by this Court.

5. Learned Central Government Standing Counsel appearing for respondents 1 & 2 submitted that the petitioner's representation dated 01.04.2025 will be considered and appropriate orders would be passed on the same within a period of six weeks.



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6. In view of the limited relief sought for by the petitioner, this Court without going into the merits of the case, directs the 1st respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 01.04.2025 and pass appropriate orders on the same on merits and in accordance with law, after affording an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner and aggrieved persons if any, within a period of six (6) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

7. Accordingly, this Writ Petition is disposed of with the aforesaid direction. No Costs.

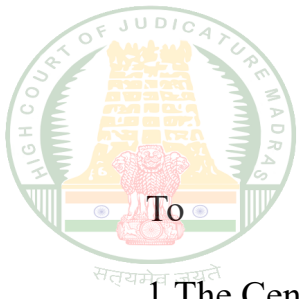
