ORDER

This application has been filed under Section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 [hereinafter referred to as 'the Act'] for the relief of interim injunction restraining the respondent from in any manner issuing emails/communications to third parties/clients and defame and derogate the name of the applicant.



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2. This Court heard learned counsel for applicant and carefully

perused the materials available on record.

3. The respondent was appointed in the applicant company by virtue of a letter of appointment dated 12.03.2025. The respondent sent a resignation letter on 24.09.2025, which was accepted by the applicant on 15.10.2025.

4. The grievance of the applicant is that after the respondent resigned, he started sending derogative messages/communications to various clients and third parties and thereby, he was damaging the reputation of the applicant company. Under such circumstances, the present application has been filed before this Court under Section 9 of the Act.

5. The appointment order contains an arbitration clause at Clause No.17 and hence, the parties are governed by the terms and conditions in the letter of appointment dated 12.03.2025.



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6. A *prima facie* case has been made out. If the respondent is sending communications to third parties by defaming the applicant, the applicant will be seriously put to irreparable loss and hardship. Hence, there shall be an order of interim injunction as prayed for till 04.12.2025.

Notice to the respondent returnable by 04.12.2025. Private notice is also permitted. The applicant shall comply with Order XXXIX Rule 3 CPC.
