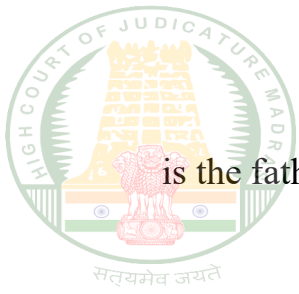

ORDER

Both parties appeared.

2. The respondent-mother has filed an application seeking interim custody of the child on account of the May vacation. As on date, the girl child, aged about 9 years, is under the care and custody of the revision petitioner, who



is the father.

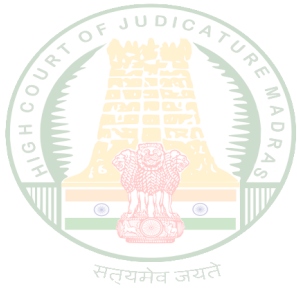

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that, though the revision petitioner/father has no serious objection to handing over the child, there have been instances when, upon such handover, the respondent/mother behaved in a manner causing disturbance and annoyance to him and his family members. Hence, he raised certain objections.

4. The learned counsel for the respondent submitted that she would take care of the child in a peaceful manner and, being the mother, she wishes to spend time with her daughter.

5. Considering that the child is studying in III Standard and that the summer vacation has commenced, this Court is of the view that the mother is entitled to have interim custody of the child during the vacation period.

6. Accordingly, this Court directs the revision petitioner/father to hand over the child to the respondent/mother on 01.05.2026. The respondent/mother is permitted to have custody of the child till 10.05.2026 and shall hand over the child back to the father on 11.05.2026. During this period, the revision petitioner/father is entitled to interact with the child through video calls at evening hours.

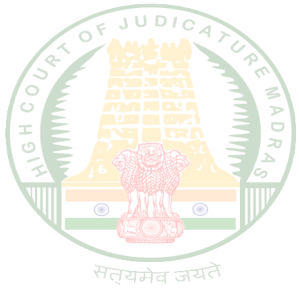
7. The respondent/mother is also directed to take proper care of the child and, in the event the child becomes unwell, to ensure appropriate medical attention.

8. Post the matter on 03.06.2026 under the caption “for reporting compliance.”
