This case is taken up today for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. Mr.Suresh Srinivasan, learned counsel for the appellant and the learned counsel for the 1st respondent Mr.N.Siva. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:



TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.20,58,800/- with interest at 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till the date of deposit as compensation and recover the same from the second respondent.

2. Aggrieved by the award of the Tribunal, the appellant/ Insurance Company had preferred the present appeal. It is reported by the appellant/ Insurance Company that they had already deposited a sum of Rs.20,58,800/- of the award amount with interest.

3. After due deliberation and consultation, both the parties have agreed to settle for a sum of Rs. Rs.25,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Lakhs only) as Full Quit.

4. The appellant/ Insurance Company is directed to withdraw the excess amount already deposited. The 1st respondent/claimant is permitted to withdraw the amount without filing any formal petition.

5. The Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of accordingly. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed, if any. The order of Tribunal with respect to pay and recovery is confirmed.
