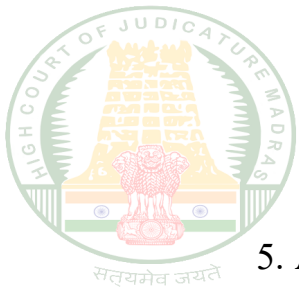
ORDER

This writ petition has been filed to direct the second respondent to consider the petitioner's application dated 15.03.2025.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has made an application dated 15.03.2025 before the official respondents seeking measurement of his property comprised in S.N.325/1B and 325/1C and fix boundary stone by using DGPS. However, the same was not considered, as on date. Hence, this writ petition.

3. Ms.Inthu Karunakaran, learned Government's Counsel appearing for respondents 1 to 3 would submit that the petitioner's application dated 15.03.2025 will be considered within a period of six weeks.

4. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the materials available on record.



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5. A perusal of the records shows that, on an earlier occasion, the official respondents used tapes to measure the petitioner's property. However, for the purpose of a survey, the official respondents are supposed to use links or a DGPS. Hence, this Court directs respondents 2 and 3 to consider the petitioner's application dated 15.03.2025, measure the property with the help of a DGPS under police protection, and fix the boundary stones and for using the said DGPS, the petitioner is directed to pay the costs. The said exercise shall be done after issuing due notice to the petitioner, respondents 5 to 7, and any other aggrieved parties, if any, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. It is made clear that the entire proceedings shall be videographed by the official respondents.

With the aforesaid observation and direction, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
