The learned counsel for the petitioners relies upon an order passed by this Court in W.P.Nos.29418 of 2024, etc. (batch), dated 10.07.2025, pertaining to the very same issue, and submits that the very same direction can be issued in these writ petitions as well, as the respondents had rejected provisional release of the subject goods on the ground that the subject goods are not freely importable. This Court in the above said batch of writ petitions had granted provisional release of the goods by imposing certain conditions.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners are willing to abide by the very same conditions for provisional release of the goods.
