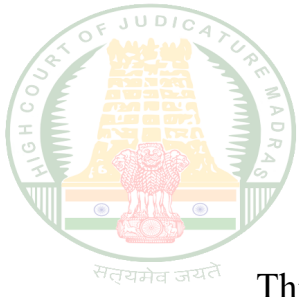

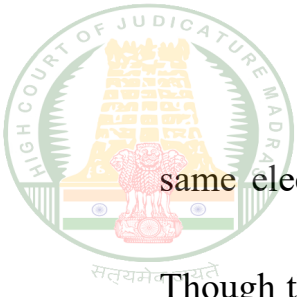

**ORDER**

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This writ petition has been filed challenging the final electoral list published by the 1st Respondent on 30.11.2025 for conducting the election to the 2nd Respondent society scheduled on 20.12.2025, quash the same insofar as it excludes the petitioners name and includes persons who do not form part of the duly authenticated list of life members of the Chennai district Branch (b) to consequently direct the 1st respondent to publish a fresh and proper electoral roll strictly based on the authenticated list of 839 life members forwarded by the District secretary of the 2nd Respondent on 07.07.2025, including the petitioners name therein, and to further direct the 1st respondent to permit the petitioner to file his nomination and to participate in the election to the 2nd Respondent society as a valid life member.

2. The learned State Government Pleader brought to the notice of this Court that the First Bench of this Court has passed series of orders in conducting of election for Indian Red Cross Society, Chennai, one such last order is dated 28.11.2025 and the matter is posted on 20.01.2026. Now, the very



same election process is sought to be challenged in the present writ petition.

Though the learned senior counsel for the petitioner would submit that the First

Bench have granted liberty to the petitioner to file separate petition to challenge the process of election or such other remedy, if they are aggrieved by the same, therefore, the present petition has been filed.

3. Though by order dated 04.08.2025, certain impleading petitions were closed giving liberty to those applicants to file separate petitions to challenge the process of election or such other remedy, if they are aggrieved by the same. This Court is of the view that since that writ petitions are pending before the First Bench of this Court, if at the petitioner has any grievance and challenges the election process by way of writ petition, that can be placed before First Bench of this Court since the main matter is pending before the First Bench.

4. Such view of the matter, Registry is directed to place this matter before the Hon'ble Chief Justice for appropriate order(s).

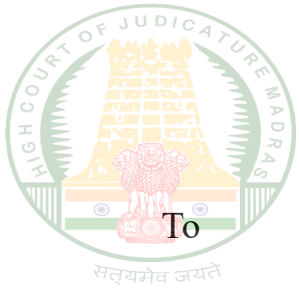
