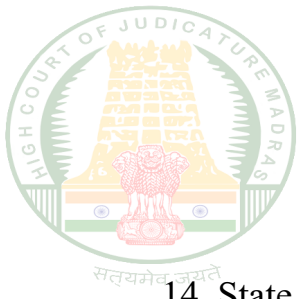

Mr.M.Ajmal Khan, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the University wants two weeks time to consult with the University officials to resolve the issue raised in these writ appeals with regard to the regularization of the temporary employees who are the writ petitioners, as out of 34 employees, 8 employees have already been regularized according to the learned Senior Counsel. With regard to remaining 26 employees, what kind of proposal can be adopted by the University to regularize them either prospectively or retrospectively, if so, monetary benefits prospectively and other service benefits

retrospectively from the date of initial appointment or both from the initial appointment would be discussed and reported before this Court for further hearing of these appeals.
