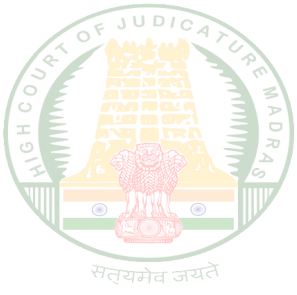

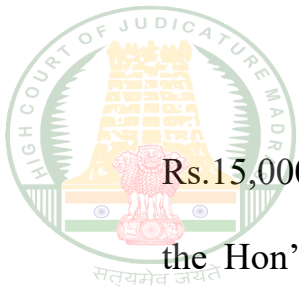

ORDER

Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, both parties appeared before this Court along with their respective counsels.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the Trial Judge without considering job and income of the respondent who is a software engineer and also running his family Flower business, has ordered him to pay Rs.15,000/- as monthly maintenance which is erroneous and illegal and liable to be set aside, prayed for enhancement.

3. It has been further submitted that while the respondent is earning not less than Rs.15,00,000/- per annum as per his income tax returns and has several rental income from his house properties, the Trial Court has granted only



Rs.15,000/- as monthly maintenance is not in conformity with the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court wherein at least one third of the income of the husband is emphasised in granting the maintenance. Hence, she seeks the relief as prayed for.

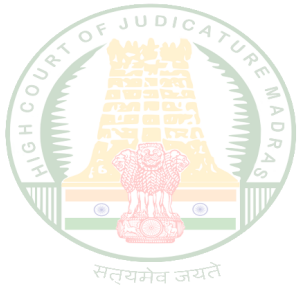
4. The learned counsel for the respondent would submit that the respondent is making loan payment and other expenses out of his meagre income, Hence, the Trial Court has rightly granted Rs.15,000/- as interim maintenance to the petitioner.

5. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the future life of the minor daughter of the parties by name Subhikshasree, pending the issue, the respondent is hereby directed to deposit Rs.5,00,000/- in the name of his daughter within a period four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

6. Post the matter on 02.06.2026 for reporting of compliance.
