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ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by R.SURESH KUMAR, J.)

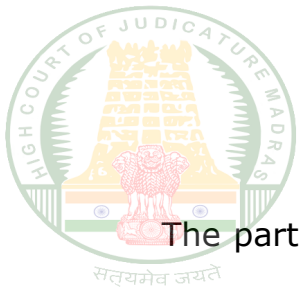
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Though the case is in the admission stage, *Mr.AR.L.Sundaresan*, the learned Senior Counsel appearing for the appellants, wants this matter to be referred to the Tamil Nadu Mediation and Conciliation Centre attached with this Court to explore the possibilities of settling the matter amicably by having negotiations between the parties.

2. Normally, after service is completed and with the consent of both sides only such action of referral would be made to the Mediation Centre, but, here in the case in hand, since it is a tangle between the family members, we hope that once it is referred to the Mediation Centre, with the able guidance and the efforts to be taken by the Mediation Centre, the issue could be settled amicably between the parties.

3. In that view of the matter, we refer the present appeal to the Tamil Nadu Mediation and Conciliation Centre attached with this Court to explore the possibilities of settling the matter amicably between the parties. Two months' time is granted to the Mediation Centre to complete the task and file a report before this Court.

4. Once the Mediation Centre receives the case papers from the Registry, they shall issue notice to the parties fixing a date for Mediation.



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The parties on receipt of such notice, without fail, shall appear before the Mediator and proceed with Mediation. Merely because notice is not served in this appeal by ordering notice by this Court, it cannot be taken as a defence by any of the parties to not to appear before the Mediator. Hence, Registry is directed to transmit the cases papers to the Mediation Centre attached with this Court immediately.

5. The property in question, on the basis of the order impugned passed by the Writ Court, shall be in the possession of the Father and he shall not further encumber the property in any circumstances until further orders.
