This Court, vide order dated 23.07.2020, passed an order permitting the petitioner/father to chat with the children through video call every Saturday.

2. Today, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks visitation right on every Saturday between 10 am and 1 pm.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent/mother has no objection for the petitioner/father visiting the children, as the children are residing with the mother. The children are residing in their grand parents house. ie., the respondent's parents house.

4. In view of the above submission made by the respondent, the petitioner is permitted to visit the children on every Saturday between 10 am and 1 pm in the residence of the respondent, where the respondent as well as their children are residing ie., at No.14/220 C1, Kodanadu Road, Pudur, Kairbetta, Kotagiri-643 217.



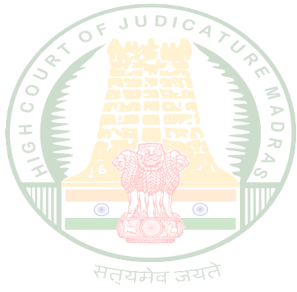
5. It is made clear that both the petitioner as well as the respondent should not quarrel with each other at the time of meeting their children. They have to move smoothly with each other to make their children happy. It is needless to say that it is up to the respondent/wife to treat the petitioner/husband smoothly, otherwise, the respondent has to receive the petitioner as a guest and treat him in a decent manner by providing coffee etc.,. The petitioner and respondent must have lunch along with their children during the visitation period, forgetting about their difference of opinion, so that the children will be very happy to have the food along with their parents. The children are entitled to have the food along with their parents and such right cannot be deprived by the parents, due to their difference of opinion in their matrimonial life. The parents have obligation to show their affection to the children and it is the right of the children to have the affection from their parents. Both the petitioner and the respondent shall comply this order without any deviation.

6. Post the matter on 10.08.2022.
