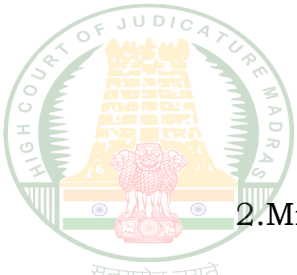

Prayer:Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India to set aside the Petition and Dockettal order, dated 04.09.2025 passed in E.P.No.68 of 2024 in C.D.No.39 of 2021 on the file of the Principal Sub Court, Madurai and allow the Present Civil Revision Petition.

ORDER

It is reported by Mr.M.Saravanan that in terms of the order dated 24.04.2026, a sum of Rs.3,38,865.50/- has been paid by the revision petitioner to the first respondent.

2.Mr.R.Krish Aravind appearing for the first respondent/ decree-holder states the first respondent has received the payments on 12.05.2026 and 19.05.2026.

3.Since it is in compliance with the orders of this Court, the interim stay granted shall continue.

4.Mr. Saravanan states that he has filed an appeal before the State of Tamil Nadu in Appeal No.13376685/G/2026-1 and the same is pending consideration. He states that in order to give a quietus to the entire issue, he is willing to pay the principal amount together with interest at the rate of 12% per annum.

5.Mr.Krish Aravind requires time to get instructions from the first respondent.

6.Being a businessman, it is hoped that they will take a pragmatic decision in the matter and receive the amounts offered rather than indulging in litigation. For Mr. Krish Aravind to report on instructions on the rate of interest that the first respondent requires to put the quietus to the issue, call the matter on 10.06.2026 under the same caption.
