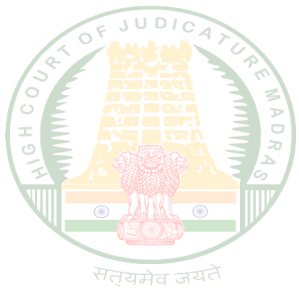

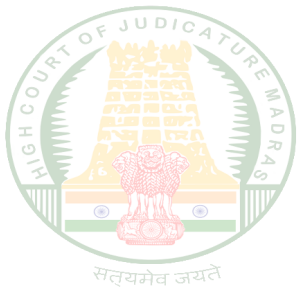

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3. Mr.Alex Benny Hook, learned counsel, submitted that he has filed vakalat for the 7th respondent and has not raised any serious objection to the present petition.

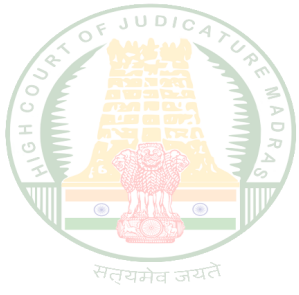
4. The learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 to 6 has also not raised any serious objection to the present petition.
