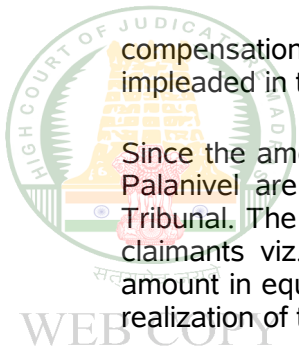

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s K.R.SIVASHANKARI and the counsel for the respondent/s MR.D.RAMESH KUMAR are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Both parties agreed for settlement of Rs.99,90,000/- (Rupees Ninety Nine lakhs Ninety Thousand only) in full quit, in as much as the third respondent viz., Saraswathi died on 01.02.2022 and the Lrs of the third respondent viz., Natarajan Veerasamy, Shanmugasundaram and V.Mohan Veerasamy, appeared before this forum today personally and filed a memo stating that they have no objection for payment of



compensation to the LRS of the deceased Palanivel. Further, the above said Lrs are or impleaded in this case as well as the main case as parties on record.

Since the amount has already been deposited, the claimants viz., wife and daughters of the deceased Palanivel are at liberty to withdraw the said amount directly from the Bank under intimation to the Tribunal. The excess amount deposited by the the Insurance Company is ordered to be refunded. The claimants viz., the wife and daughters of the deceased Palanivel are entitled to withdraw the said amount in equal propotion. Further, the Insurance Compalny is at liberty to take proper proceedings for realization of the above said amount as already ordered by the Tribunal in its award.
