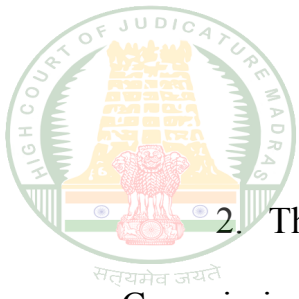

2. The learned counsel for the appellant would submit that the Joint Commissioner has erroneously fixed the income of the employee at Rs.38,462/- as against the ceiling limit of Rs.15,000/- and that the appellant has already deposited the entire award amount as directed by the Joint Commissioner. He would further submit that the Joint Commissioner may be directed not to disburse the award amount till the disposal of the appeal.

3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the appellant and also perused the records.

4. Post the matter after four weeks.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances, the learned Joint Commissioner of Labour, Madurai, is directed not to disburse more than 50 % of the award amount.
