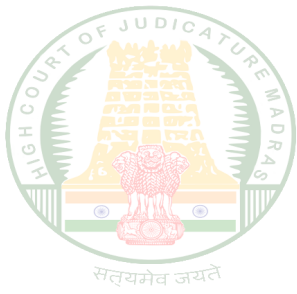

4. The names of respondents 3 to 7 have been printed in the cause list.

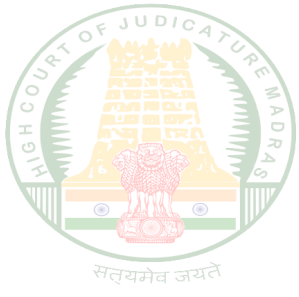
5. Being satisfied with the reasons stated in the affidavit, these Civil Miscellaneous Petitions are allowed.
