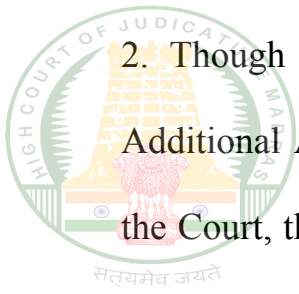

2. Though I am not convinced with the submissions made on the merits, Additional Advocate General pleads that if the respondent contractor were to appear before the Court, there is a possibility for the parties to settle the amount at a lesser figure than that awarded by the Executing Court.

3. Hence, issue notice to the decree holder / respondent as well as to the counsel who represented the decree holder before the Court below.

4. In the event, the decree holder is not willing to settle, the Government runs the risk of costs being imposed.
