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ORDER

2. Despite receipt of notice, the second respondent has not turned up.

3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing for the first respondent.

4. It is not in dispute that the appeal filed by the claimant is pending in C.M.A. (MD)No.952 of 2025.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances and taking note of the quantum of delay, this Court is inclined to condone the delay but on terms. Hence, this petition will be allowed on payment of cost of **Rs.750/- (Rupees Seven Hundred and Fifty only)** by the petitioner to the Madurai Bench of Madras High Court Advocates Welfare Fund [Indian Bank High Court Branch, Madurai, Current Account No.7087208431, IFSC IDIB000H040], on or before **16.04.2026**, failing which, this petition shall stand dismissed automatically.
