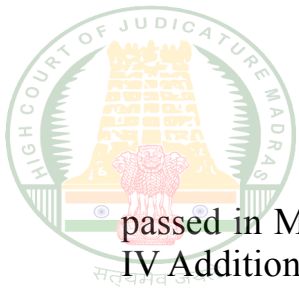

Prayer in CMA(MD)No.335 of 2026 : This Civil Miscellaneous Appeal filed under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicles Act praying to set aside the award dated 25.11.2025 passed in M.C.O.P.No.451 of 2019 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal / IV Additional Subordinate Judge of Madurai by allowing this appeal.

ORDER

The above petition has been filed to stay the award dated 25.11.2025 passed in M.C.O.P.No.451 of 2019 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal / IV Additional Subordinate Court, Madurai, pending disposal of the civil miscellaneous appeal.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the deceased Murugesan was admitted in Government Hospital and was discharged on 31.10.2018 and he filed the claim petition on 21.02.2019 and pending claim petition, he died on 15.09.2019 and that the respondents 1 to 4, who were impleaded subsequently, have not proved the nexus between the injuries suffered in the accident and the cause of death.



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4. Perused the records.

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5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be an order of interim stay on condition that the petitioner / Insurance Company shall deposit the **entire award amount** together with interest and costs to the credit of **M.C.O.P.No.451 of 2019** on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal / IV Additional Subordinate Judge, Madurai, within a period of **four weeks** from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, failing which, the interim order granted shall stand vacated automatically without any further reference to this Court.

6. Issue notice to the respondents returnable by four weeks. Private notice is also permitted.
