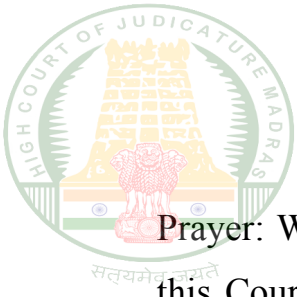

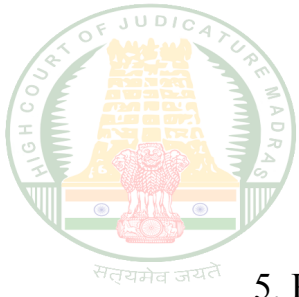
ORDER

2. In the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, it is stated that the new policy has been violated by granting permission to the 3rd respondent. It is further stated that while 1/3rd of the route alone can be serviced route. In this case, the entire route is being serviced by the petitioner.

3. This Court *prima facie* finds merit in the above submission. In view thereof, there shall be an order of interim stay of all further proceedings till 26.03.2026.

4. Issue notice to 3rd respondent returnable by 26.03.2026. Private notice is also permitted.
