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PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to forthwith refer the petitioner to the Medical Board of K.A.P.Vishwanatham Government Medical College affiliated with Tamil Nadu Doctor M.G.R.Medical University, situated at Periyamilagupaarai, Trichy or to any other Government Hospital to ascertain his medical fitness to work as Conductor and to provide him suitable alternative light work on permanent basis at Lalgudi Branch of 1st respondent Corporation and post him in any suitable post with light duty along with pay protection, continuity of service and back wages from the date of disengagement i.e., from 21.09.2025 to 20.01.2026 as per Section 20(4) of the Rights of the Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, within a time frame that may be fixed by this Court.

ORDER

Mr.S.C.Herold Singh, learned Standing Counsel, takes notice for the respondent – Transport Corporation.



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2. With the consent of both sides, this writ petition is disposed of at the admission stage.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondent – Transport Corporation.

4. Learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondent – Transport Corporation, on instructions, fairly submitted that the respondents immediately would take steps for referring the petitioner to the Medical Board as requested by him.

5. In the light of the same, this Court does not see any reason to examine the matter on merits and accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents to refer the petitioner to the Medical Board to ascertain the medical fitness of the petitioner to work as a Conductor. In case the petitioner is found to be unfit for discharging the functions of Conductor, he shall be provided with an alternative employment strictly in accordance with the provisions of the Rights of the Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of the report from the



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Medical Board. However, the claim made for payment of backwages from 21.09.2025 to 20.01.2026 is concerned, the same is left open to be agitated independently by the petitioner after the report from the Medical Board is received. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
