PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the first respondent to cancel the patta in favour of the third respondent in respect of the properties in Survey Nos.386/2, 391, 397/1B1, 397/1B4 in Patta No.3589 total extent 3 acre 66 cents which is situated at Sengirichi Village, Dindigul East Taluk, Dindigul and to transfer the said mentioned Patta No.3589 to the petitioner's name based on petitioner's representation dated 15.12.2025 within a stipulated period as prescribed by this Court.

ORDER

The present Writ Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the first respondent to cancel the patta issued in favour of the third respondent in respect of the properties comprised in Survey Nos.386/2, 391, 397/1B1, and 397/1B4, covered under Patta No.3589, measuring a total extent of 3 acres and 66 cents, situated at Sengurichi Village, Dindigul East Taluk, Dindigul District, and consequently transfer the said Patta No.3589 in favour of the petitioner, based on the petitioner's representation dated 15.12.2025, within a stipulated period as may be prescribed by this Court.

2. The petitioner submitted that the subject property had been purchased as early as in the year 1936. Thereafter, the petitioner's father intended to execute a settlement deed in favour of the petitioner. At that time, it came to their knowledge that the patta had already been issued in the name of the third respondent. Hence, the petitioner's father filed an application before the first respondent challenging the issuance of patta in favour of the third respondent.



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During the pendency of the proceedings, the petitioner's father passed away.

Thereafter, the petitioner continued to pursue the matter and submitted a fresh representation dated 04.03.2026, which is still pending before the first respondent.

3. Therefore, the first respondent is directed to consider the petitioner's representation and pass appropriate orders, after issuing notice to the petitioner as well as the third respondent, and conclude the proceedings within a period of five (5) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. With the above direction, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
