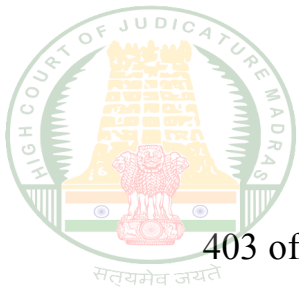
ORDER

4. The learned counsel on either side unanimously agree that the issue involved in this Writ Petition is squarely covered by the various judgments passed by the Division Bench of this Court in W.A.(MD) No.



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403 of 2010 and batch, dated 18.03.2014 [*The Managing Director, Tamil*

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Nadu State Transport Corporation (Madurai) Limited, Bye-Pass Road,

Madurai and another vs. A. Thambi Raj and others] and in W.A.(MD)

No.1419 of 2021 and batch, dated 26.07.2021 [*A. Tamilarasan vs. The*

Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation (Kumbakonam) Ltd.,

represented by its Managing Director, Kumbakonam and another].

In the said circumstances, this Writ Petition is allowed and the respondents are directed to pay interest at the rate of 6% per annum for the belated payment of the petitioner's terminal benefits, including Commutation, Gratuity, Provident Fund, Old Earned Leave Salary and New Earned Leave Salary, from the date of his retirement till the date on which the said terminal benefits are paid to the petitioner. The respondents are further directed to comply with the said direction as expeditiously as possible, at any rate, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
