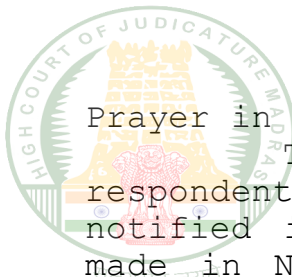

Petition filed praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the affidavit filed therewith the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records culminating in the impugned notification of the third and fourth respondents dated 01.03.2023 made in Na.Ka.No.4374/2022/A1 and to quash the same in so far as the two posts of Assistant Cook in S.I.No.6 as well as clause (16) of the notification and consequently direct the 3rd and 4th respondents to regularise the petitioners in the two posts of Assistant Cook as per the proceedings of 1st respondent dated 20.04.2020 made in Na.Ka.No.52261/2012/I1.



Prayer in WMP(MD)No. 7120/ 2023 :

To grant an order of interim injunction restraining the respondents from filling up the posts of two Assistant Cooks notified in S.No.6 of the impugned notification dated 01.03.2023 made in Na.Ka.No.4374/2022/A1 pending disposal of the above writ petition.

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ORDER : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of MRS.P.THILAGAVATHI, Senior Counsel for M/S.GOPINATH R, Advocate for the petitioner and of MR.C.BASKARAN, Government Advocate on behalf of the Respondents 1 & 2, the court made the following order:-

The learned senior counsel for the petitioner points out that this writ petition was filed in March 2023 and it should not be rendered as infructuous, if the applications received by the employer pursuant to the impugned notice are finalized. I find force in the said contention. The respondents are restrained from finalizing the recruitment process. The interim order is confined to two posts of Assistant Cooks alone.

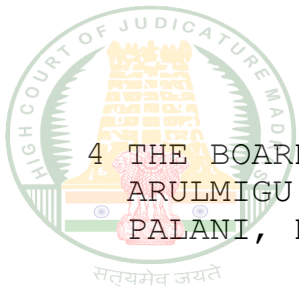
