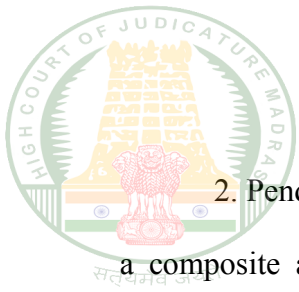

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr.N.Shyllappa Kalyan and the counsel for the first respondent/s Mr.N.Sudhakar Nagaraj are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

The Insurance Company is on appeal challenging the award passed in favour of the first respondent for injuries sustained in a motor accident. The Tribunal has awarded a sum of 11,58,265/- payable with interest at 7.5 % p.a. from the date of filing of the claim petition.



2. Pending this appeal, the parties have negotiated an amicable settlement and have arrived at a composite and consolidated figure of Rs.9 Lakhs [Rupees Nine Lakhs] in full quit [without interest], excluding the 50% of the award amount in respect of which the parties have already reached settlement. The insurance company shall deposit the present award amount, less the amount already deposited, if any, within a period of four [4] weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. In view of the settlement arrived at, the respondent / claimant is permitted to withdraw the entire award amount without filing any formal petition.

3. This Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of on the above terms. No costs. Connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
