Today, this case is listed under the caption “for being mentioned”.

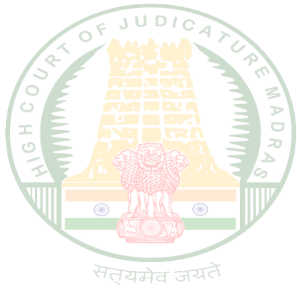
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2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the date of death of the petitioner’s husband and the name of one of her daughters were incorrectly mentioned in the petition. This Court had earlier disposed of the case on 30.03.2026. However, in the order copy, the petitioner’s husband’s date of death was recorded as 16.12.2024 and one of the daughters was named as Suradeepika, whereas the correct date of death is 26.12.2024 and the correct name of the daughter is Sukadeepa. Therefore, the learned counsel for the petitioner requested this Court to make the necessary corrections in the said order and to issue a corrected copy of the order.

3. Considering the above submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court is modified para 4 and 8 of the order as follows:-

" 4. The petitioner is the wife of Late Mr.Muthupandi. They were blessed with two daughters, namely Ms.Deepika and Ms.Sukadeepa. The petitioner's husband was working as a P.G. Assistant in the third respondent school. While so, he passed away on 26.12.2024, leaving behind the petitioner and their two daughters. The third respondent school disbursed the monetary benefits payable upon his death; however, the CPS amount due from the first respondent has not been disbursed to the petitioner.

8. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and in particular the fact that the petitioner's husband passed away on 26.12.2024 and the CPS funds have not



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yet been disbursed, this Court, without going into the merits of the matter, directs the petitioner to submit a fresh representation to the Commissioner, Government Data Centre, Guindy, Chennai, clarifying the discrepancy in her name with supporting documents as expeditiously as possible."

4. Registry is directed to carry-out the necessary corrections in the order dated 30.03.2026 in WP(MD).No.8496 of 2026 and issue fresh order copy to the learned counsel for the petitioner.
