ORDER

Today, the respondent's son is present before this Court in person. At the previous hearing, proposals for an amicable settlement were exchanged. However, today, a new offer has been made on the side of the respondent. The respondent has expressed willingness to purchase the share of the purchaser of the 9/10th share from the family.

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2. The learned counsel appearing on both sides submitted that if the parties are referred to mediation and are properly guided and advised, there is a possibility of an amicable settlement being arrived at between them.

3. In the light of the above, the matter is referred to the Tamil Nadu Mediation and Conciliation Centre attached to this Court. The parties are directed to appear before the Mediation Centre on 04.06.2026. It is further permitted that the respondent's son, viz., Mr. Mansoor Yasik, shall represent the respondent, as the respondent is not in a position to appear personally before the Mediation Centre. The appellant shall also appear before the Mediation Centre on the said date. The mediation process shall be completed within a period of two weeks thereafter.
