Already this Court appointed one Mr.N.Rajapanth, as Advocate Commissioner and he has filed a report. Today, it is reported even though there is an interim order not to lay road, there is an allegation by the petitioner that the respondent is laying the road.

2.The Learned Government Advocate appearing for the official respondents submitted that the stay is only for the North-South particularly to plot No.69 and 70 which belongs to the petitioner and they are laying road for East-West direction. The said statement is recorded. In order to verify the same, the said Mr.N.Rajapanth is again directed to verify the said fact and submit a report before this Court. The fees for the Advocate Commissioner will be fixed on the next hearing. The Advocate Commissioner is specifically directed to verify the fact whether there is a road intersecting in between the petitioner's plot.
