Prayer in the main appeal:

Appeal (CAD) filed under section 96 of Civil Procedure Code to set aside the Decree and Judgment in COS No.73/2015, on the file of the Honourable Principal District and Sessions Judge, Virudhunagar District at Srivilliputhur dated 30.01.2026 and allow the Appeal with costs and decree the suit in its entirety and thus render justice.



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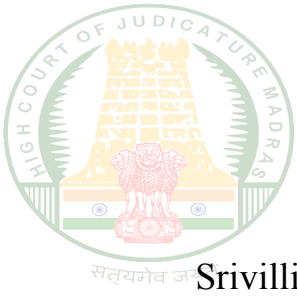
Prayer in C.M.P.(MD).No.5191 of 2026 : Petition filed under Section 151 of CPC to grant stay of all further proceedings of the decree and judgment dated 30.01.2026 in COS.No.73 of 2025 on the file of the Principal District and Sessions Court, Virudhunagar District at Srivilliputhur.

ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by the Hon'ble N.Anand Venkatesh J.)

Mr.N.Dilipkumar, learned counsel, has entered appearance by means of a Caveat filed on behalf of the respondent.

2. Considering the fact that a statutory appeal has been filed, we are not inclined to go into the merits of the appeal for the present. However, considering the fact that the suit itself took more than ten years for its disposal and considering the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for the Caveator to the effect that as on date, a sum of Rs.74,00,000/- is due and payable by the Appellant / Defendant, we are inclined to grant an order of interim stay subject to the condition that the appellant shall deposit the entire amount as decreed by the trial Court along with the accrued interest to the credit of COS.No.73 of 2025 on the file of the Principal District and Sessions Court, Virudhunagar District at



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Srivilliputhur, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Failure to comply with this condition, will result in the interim stay standing automatically vacated without any further reference to this Court.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the appellant shall serve the papers to the learned counsel for the respondent.

4. Registry is directed to post this appeal for final hearing on **12.06.2026**. In the meantime, Registry is further directed to call for the original records from the concerned Court.
