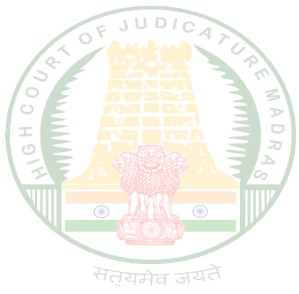

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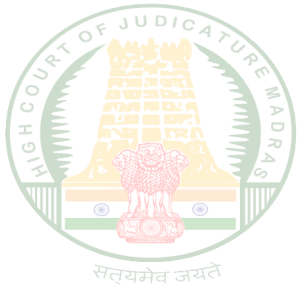
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ORDER

The petitioner, claiming to be the owner of the plot situated in Survey No. 107/142, Nanjil Nagar South, Therekalputhur, Agastheeswaram Circle, Kanniyakumari District, is before this Court seeking a direction to the respondents to remove the transformer, along with the electricity connection and the electric poles.

2.The petitioner states that the respondents, without following due process of law, had erected the transformer and drawn electricity lines and electric poles. Therefore, he submitted a representation to the respondents seeking removal of the transformer, electricity lines, and electric poles. The grievance of the petitioner is that the said representation has not been considered as on date. The petitioner further states that he is not liable to pay charges under the deposited contribution work, since the transformer was allegedly erected illegally in the year 2017 without his consent.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the respondents submitted that the representation submitted by the petitioner would be considered in accordance with law within the time frame fixed by this Court.



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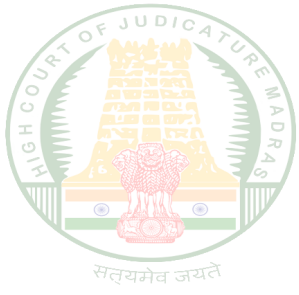
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4.The said submission is taken on record.
