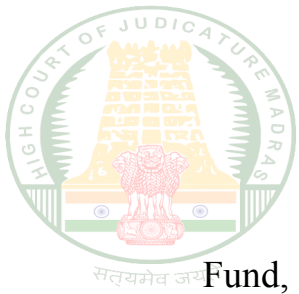

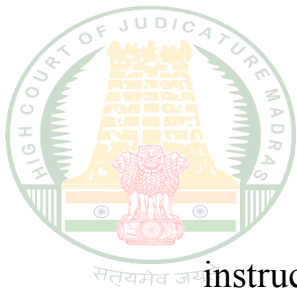

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the first respondent to settle the dues, namely, subsistence allowance, travel allowance, provident fund, monthly pension, commutation of pension, gratuity, leave encashment, group insurance and other attendant benefits, by considering the representation dated 11.03.2026 alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner before the first respondent.

2. This matter earlier came up for consideration before this Court on 10.04.2026 and the same was adjourned to enable Mr.N.Dilip Kumar, learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents, to get



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instructions in the matter.

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3. Today, when the matter is taken up for consideration, Mr.N.Dilip Kumar, learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents, submitted that the eligible amounts due and payable to the petitioner will be paid within a period of eight weeks from today, duly considering the representation dated 11.03.2026 submitted by the petitioner.

4. In the light of the above, this Writ Petition is disposed of, directing the first respondent to consider the representation dated 11.03.2026 and release all eligible amounts due and payable to the petitioner as expeditiously as possible, at any rate, within a period of eight weeks from today. No costs.
