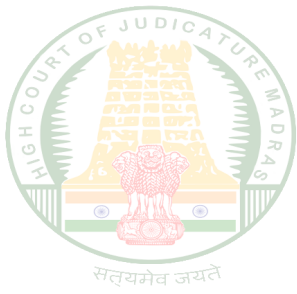

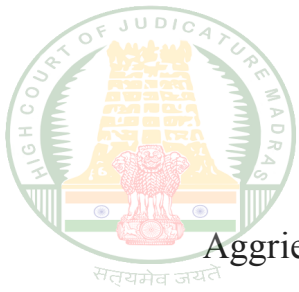
ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the first respondent to consider and dispose of the appeal dated 19.10.2022 preferred by the petitioner against the order of punishment issued by the second respondent in his proceedings in Sey.Mu.AA.No.A1/02136/2018 dated 16.08.2022, within such time as may be stipulated by this Court.

2. Heard Mr.H.Mohammed Imran, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.S.Shaji Bino, learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

3. With the consent of both parties, this Writ Petition is disposed of at the admission stage itself.

4. The grievance of the petitioner in the present Writ Petition is that he was subjected to punishment by the second respondent *vide* proceedings bearing Sey.Mu.AA.No.A1/02136/2018 dated 16.08.2022.

Aggrieved by the said punishment, the petitioner has filed an appeal before the first respondent as early as 19.10.2022. However, the said appeal is still pending without any action on the part of the first respondent. Hence, the petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present Writ Petition seeking expeditious disposal of the said appeal.

5. Mr.S.Shaji Bino, learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents, submitted that the appeal filed by the petitioner, if pending, would be disposed of within a period of eight weeks without fail.

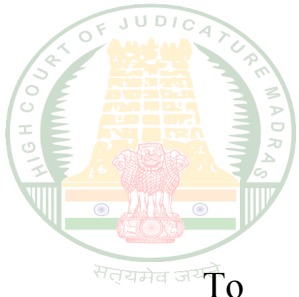

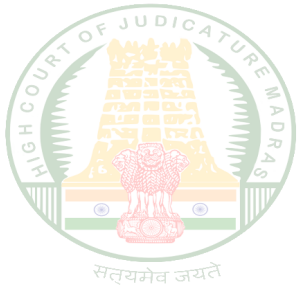
