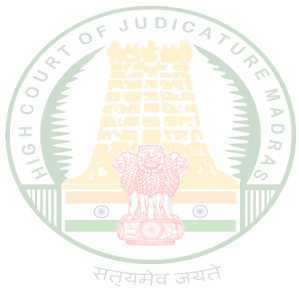

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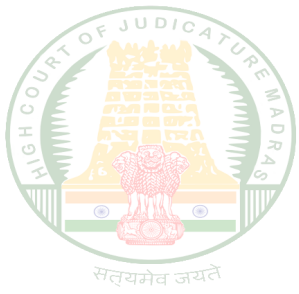
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ORDER

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the second respondent to conclude the enquiry pursuant to the complaint dated 21.07.2025 filed under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007.

2. Heard Mr. R. Ganeshprabu, learned counsel for the petitioner, and Ms. P.B. Ahamed Yasmin Parvin, learned Government Advocate, who accepts notice on behalf of respondents 1 to 3.

3. The petitioner states that respondents 4 and 5, who are his son and daughter-in-law, drove him and his wife out of the residential property. Therefore, he filed a complaint before the third respondent, which was subsequently transferred to the second respondent, seeking a direction to respondents 4 and 5 to maintain him and his wife. The grievance of the petitioner is that the said complaint has not been disposed of till date.



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4. Ms. P.B. Ahamed Yasmin Parvin, learned Government Advocate for respondents 1 to 3, on instructions, submitted that the complaint dated 21.07.2025 filed by the petitioner would be considered on merits and disposed of in accordance with law within the time frame fixed by this Court. The said submission is taken on record.

5. In view of the above, the writ petition stands disposed of with a direction to the second respondent to dispose of the petitioner's complaint dated 21.07.2025, on its own merits and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as respondents 4 and 5.

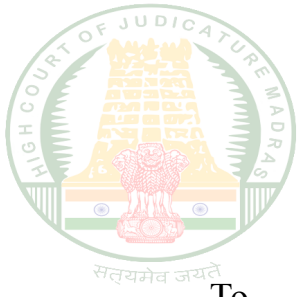
6. The aforesaid exercise shall be completed within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

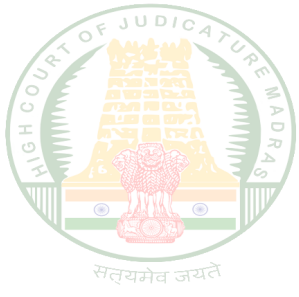
