PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records pertaining to the impugned proceedings in Na.Ka.Pani.4(3)/7936152/2024 dated 25.10.2025 on the file of the Respondent No. 2 and the consequential impugned order in Na.Ka.No. A3/5212/2024 dated 29.11.2025 on the file of the Respondent No. 3, and to quash the same as illegal in so far as not regularising the period of dismissal from service and consequentially, for a direction, directing the

Respondents to regularise the dismissal period from service of the petitioner as the duty period within the time stipulated by this Court.

ORDER

This matter came up earlier for consideration on 27.04.2026 and the same was adjourned for filing counter. However, today no counter is filed. The learned Government Counsel seeks further time to file counter.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the issue needs to be adjudication in the present writ petition is only in respect of the payment of the salary for the period during which the petitioner was dismissed from the service and therefore, the petitioner requested for passing appropriate orders directing the respondents to release the undisputed amount due and payable to the petitioner pursuant to the impugned proceedings.

3. As the challenge to the impugned proceedings is only to the

limited extent, the other benefits, for which the petitioner is entitled to, cannot be withheld by the respondents either on the ground of pendency of writ petition or otherwise. Hence, the respondents have to release all the benefits for which the petitioner is entitled to under the impugned proceedings.

4. In the circumstances, there shall be a interim direction directing the respondents to release all the amounts due and payable to the petitioner in terms of the impugned proceedings dated 25.10.2025 as expeditiously as possible at any rate within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
