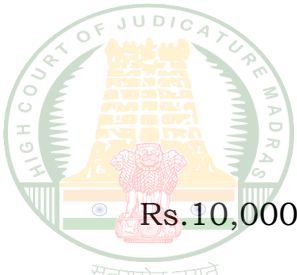

Prayer: Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of The Constitution of India to set aside the order dated 17.03.2026 passed in Memo in O.S.No.506 of 2022 on the file of the learned II Additional Subordinate Judge, Tiruchirappalli and consequently permit the petitioners to cross examine DW1.

ORDER

Mr.V.R.Shanmuganathan states that he will cross-examine D.W.1 and D.W.2 on the date fixed by the Court. He states that he will also pay a sum of



Rs.10,000/- each as costs for D.W.1 and D.W.2 to appear before the Court.

Mr.Shanmuganathan shall take notice on Mr.K.Benjamin and Mr.N.Selvam, the counsel, who represented the defendants before the trial Court.

2.Post on 23.06.2026.

3.It is represented by Mr.Shanmuganathan that the learned Trial Judge has listed the matter for judgment on 22.06.2026. The learned trial Judge is operating under a direction of this Court to dispose of the suit. Hence, the said order has been passed. In case, the judgment is pronounced without the plaintiff having cross-examined defendants 1 and 2, there would be no game for the plaintiff to play. An uncontroverted evidence would have to be taken as an admission. Hence, there shall be an order of interim stay till 23.06.2026.

4.Registry to inform the learned II Additional Subordinate Judge, Thiruchirappalli, about the stay by e-mail forthwith. In addition, Mr.Shanmuganathan will also intimate the Court regarding the grant of interim order by way of a memo.
