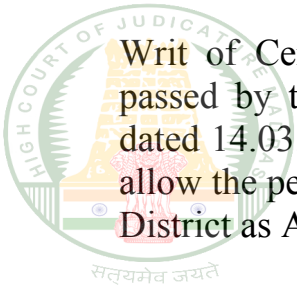

ORDER

The grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner is being singled out and he is being repeatedly transferred. Further, in the instant case, only to accommodate the fourth respondent, the petitioner is shunted out. In view of the said contention, notice should be served on the fourth respondent.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that already private notice is served and he will file the affidavit of service. In view thereof, call on 01.06.2026. Let affidavit of service be filed.

3. In the meanwhile, if the petitioner is willing to join the transferred place, he can join without prejudice to his contentions. If the petitioner succeeds in the Writ Petition, once again the petitioner will be retained in the original place itself. Therefore, without prejudice to the pendency of the writ petition, let the petitioner be permitted to join in the transferred place.
