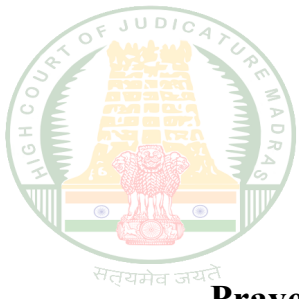

Even if the petitioner as a third party is aggrieved by the same, it will be very well open for the petitioner to file an application to implead himself in the writ petition and file a vacate stay application.

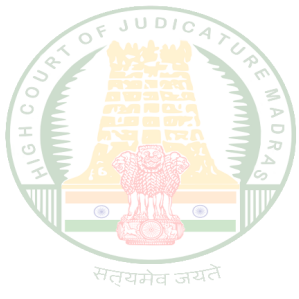
