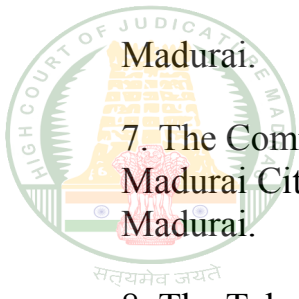

**Prayer:** Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the Respondents 5, 6 and 8 to immediately survey, measure, demarcate, and remove all illegal fences, unauthorized structures, and encroachments in the Sarkar Poramboke lands and the Karuppannasamy Temple premises comprised in Madurai City Corporation Ward 18, Block 12, Town Survey No. 1, Re-Survey Nos. 9/1 and 9/2, measuring an extent of 16.50 Ares, and secure the same under absolute Government custody and also directing the Respondents 2 and 3 to immediately take over the absolute administration, management, and custody of the said Karuppannasamy Temple situated in Re-Survey No. 9/1 based on my representation dated 14.5.2026 and also directing the Respondents 7 and 9 to act upon the complaints submitted by petitioner and his wife, In-person before DCP North, dated 12.5.26 and 13.5.26 to take necessary legal action against the named culprits for criminal intimidation and attempted assault and pass such other orders as this Honourable court may deem fit and proper in these circumstances and thus render justice.

### **ORDER**

The writ petition is filed to evict the encroachers from sarkar poramboke lands. Not even one encroacher is made as party. Learned counsel for the petitioner is requested to file an impleading petition at least to implead few of the encroachers, so that orders can be passed after hearing them.
