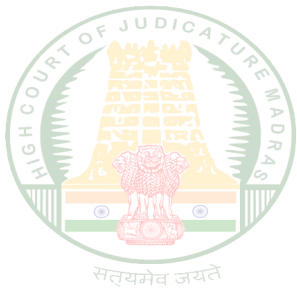

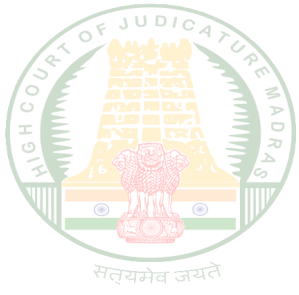
ORDER

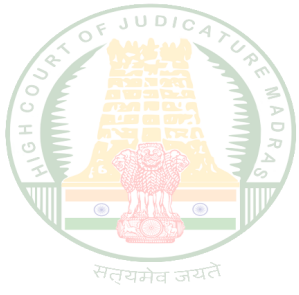
