JUDGMENT

This appeal suit has been filed against the judgment and decree made in O.S.No.62 of 2012, dated 25.04.2014, on the file of the II-Additional District Judge, Tiruchirappalli.

2. Heard both side and perused the records including the Mediation Report along with the joint compromise memo filed by the parties.

3. When the matter was taken up for hearing on 13.08.2024, at request of both parties, the matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre attached to this Court for arriving at an amicable settlement between the parties. After mediation, the matter is ordered to be posted before this Court. As per the



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order of this Court, mediation was conducted and the mediation report has been filed today. Perusal of the report shows that both parties were appeared before the Mediation centre and arrived at a settlement by filing a joint memo of compromise in which both parties are agreed for certain conditions and also put their signatures.

4.This Appeal Suit is disposed of in terms of the Mediation Report and the joint compromise memo of settlement arrived by the parties. The said Mediation Report and the joint compromise memo shall form part and parcel of the order. The parties are directed to strictly adhere the conditions mentioned in the joint memo of compromise, failing which the order shall stand vacated automatically without further reference to this Court. No Costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
