PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a writ of Mandamus directing the third respondent to resubmit that revised family pension proposed in furtherance of the letter of the 2nd respondent in नि.प्र.गण:इ-1176743/नि.क्र.स(2)/25 dated 18.09.2025 (Pay Order No. 33491/M) to the 2nd respondent to authorize full-fledged family pension and Death cum Retirement Gratuity (DCRG) entitled to the petitioner, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 04.05.2026, within the period that may be stipulated by this Court.

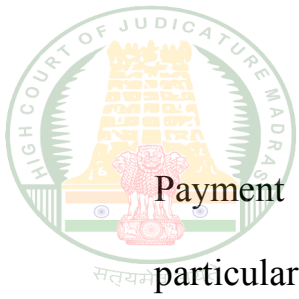

ORDER

The writ petition has been filed seeking issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the third respondent to resubmit the revised family pension proposal, pursuant to the proceedings of the second respondent in Ref.No. नि.प्र.गण:इ-1176743/न.ओ.श(2)/25, dated 18.09.2025 (Pay Order No.33491/M), to the second respondent, so as to enable the second respondent to authorise the full-fledged family pension and Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity (DCRG) to which the petitioner is entitled, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 04.05.2026.

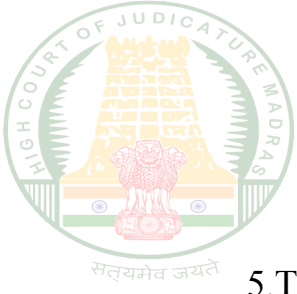
2.The petitioner herein has been drawing family pension and arrears of family pension pursuant to the proceedings of the second respondent in Ref.No. नि.प्र.गण:इ-1176743/न.ओ.श(2)/25, dated 18.09.2025. While issuing the said proceedings, the second respondent required the third respondent to comply with certain conditions stipulated in the NHO appended to the said Pension



Payment Order. However, owing to the non-submission of the necessary particulars and proposals by the third respondent, the petitioner is unable to draw the full family pension to which she is otherwise entitled.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the respondents, on instructions, submitted that all the legal heirs of the deceased employee, namely, Late V.Ravi, are required to affix their signatures in Form-12, so as to enable the third respondent to submit the requisite particulars and proposals to the second respondent. It is submitted that there appears to be a dispute among the legal heirs of the deceased employee, Late V.Ravi, and, therefore, the third respondent is not in a position to submit Form-12 as required by the second respondent in the proceedings dated 18.09.2025.

4.In view of the above submission, the third respondent is directed to comply with the other requirements, namely, Requirements Nos.1, 2 and 4 mentioned in Annexure-II to the proceedings dated 18.09.2025, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



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5.The writ petition is disposed of with the above direction. There shall be no order as to costs.
