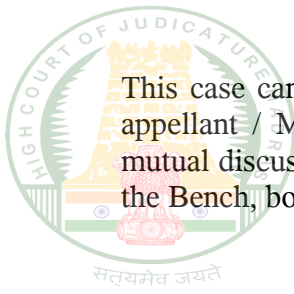

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The court has heard the appellant / Mr.V.Sakthivel and the counsel for the respondents 1 to 5/ Ms.B.Lalli are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Both parties agreed for settlement of Rs.26,00,000/- in full quit. Since the amount has already been deposited, the parties are at liberty to withdraw their share amount in the ratio as apportioned by the Tribunal. The share amount due to the minor claimants viz., Mohith and Pueela Sri, shall be deposited in fixed deposit in the same Bank until they attain majority. The guardian/ mother viz., Priyanka, can withdraw the accrued interest once in three months directly from the Bank under intimation to the Tribunal. The excess amount if any, is ordered to be refunded.

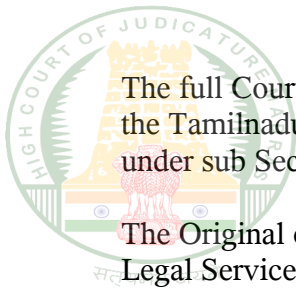
